SUBJECT: RESERVE PARACHUTES FITTED WITH AN AAD

STATUS: MANDATORY

<u>IDENTIFICATION:</u> All brands and models of sport parachute equipment with an AAD

(automatic activation device) installed on the reserve parachute.

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> There is an increasing use of AADs on reserve parachutes used for

skydiving. These can be electronic, and/or pyrotechnic, and/or mechanical but generally have periodic servicing requirements. Often the AAD service will fall due before the 6-monthly inspection of the

reserve parachute is due.

The 1997 APF Technical discussed this and recommended a policy for

the APF to promulgate as a RAC.

APF POLICY: Where the AAD is due to be serviced to have: 1) the batteries replaced,

and/or 2) a factory service, before the reserve parachute must be inspected, the packer must only sign off the reserve until the first AAD

service is due.

To facilitate this policy the APF provides Packing Cards (illustrated below), free of charge to APF members, for recording the AAD serial number, battery replacement and factory service date in addition to the

other information required by RAC 106.
