SUBJECT: APF POLICY ON COLOUR CODING STEERING TOGGLES

FOR STUDENT TRAINING PARACHUTES.

STATUS: RECOMMENDED

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> A student training organisation experienced a fatality when the

student cutaway from a main parachute for no apparent reason and

then failed to activate the reserve parachute.

The steering toggles for the main parachute were yellow.

The student had been instructed to steer the main parachute using the

'yellow' steering toggles fitted by the manufacturer.

As is customary the SOS uses a 'yellow' handle to activate the

cutaway and reserve deployment.

When the fatality was investigated it was considered conceivable that

the student mistakenly operated the yellow SOS handle in the belief

that this would steer the main parachute.

<u>APF POLICY:</u> It is recommended that steering toggles on student main parachute

assemblies be colour coded mid blue and that students be trained to

identify the toggles by the colour.
