<u>SUBJECT</u>	CHEST PARACHUTE RIPCORDS
<u>STATUS</u>	Advisory
IDENTIFICATION	QAC P/N A531, Cable 6 3/8" QAC P/N A530, B530. T10R, cable 6 ³ / ₄ " QAC P/N MS70112, Cable 6 5/8" Chest reserve T7A Cable 7"
BACKGROUND	The QAC (Quick attachable chest) parachute is intended for stowage inside an aircraft and attached to a harness worn by an aircrew member for the case of an inflight emergency.
	The chest parachute is intended as a reserve parachute for premeditated parachute descents.
	QAC reserve parachute ripcords are distinguishable by their shorter ripcord cable length and sleeve swaged between the handle and first pin.
<u>APF POLICY</u>	A chest reserve parachute must only be fitted with a T7A ripcord of cable length 7".
	For Winter operations, a chest reserve parachute ripcord may be reserve in the pocket to make it prominent and easy to grip with a gloved hand.
