Subject Matter and Applicability	RESERVE CANOPY CONTROL  All Parachutes de France Reserve Canopies  AERAZUR Service Bulletin BS 25-63-46, dated 12 December 2008.  This Service Bulletin states:- 'During the packing of a reserve canopy (training parachutes in service in the French Army), the rigger observed that a ring used to stop the riser was missing'  Note – the word riser (in red above) is incorrect; the correct word is 'slider'.  Bullets de glisser   Parte haute dec commandes   Upper Stering lines

Compliance	As a precaution, at the next periodic inspection/packing of the reserve (all types), it is recommended to verify that all slider stops are present and to mention this control on canopy official documents.  Compliance to be by Senior or Master Rigger or equivalent according to the local regulation.
