

Sporting Code changes for 2018

References to SCC (Sport and Competition Committee)

References to Intermediate Formation Skydiving changed to Blast and A events

References to Open Formation Skydiving changed to AA and AAA events

Judges section (3) rewritten.

Accuracy:

No changes.

Formation skydiving:

Jumps per day, and time between jumps for Blast and A

1 Tie Break to decide placings

8 Way Open draw is 5 or 6 formations

8 Way Inter draw is 4 or 5 formations (had been dropped in error in 2017).

Removal of requirement for one continuously video clip starting with the team number.

Equipment problems now INCLUDES video gear, and will not be grounds for a rejump.

Canopy Formation: No changes.

Canopy Piloting: No changes.

Freestyle and FreeFlying:

Equipment problems now INCLUDES video gear, and will not be grounds for a rejump.

Camera scoring and deductions

Free routines have 3 judges for execution, 2 for camera.

Must submit the order for the compulsories, and chosen maximum values before the start of competition.

Freestyle Compulsories:

FR-3 Max value addition

FR-5 Judging guideline added

FR-7 Max value addition

Freefly Compulsories:

Video image must be upright, or 70% max

FF-1 Rotating in the wrong direction gives 50% max

FF-2 Grip definitions, judging guidelines

FF-4 Max value additions/changes

Wingsuiting:

Designated flight path starts 5 seconds after exit, and is 600metres wide

Grip definitions

Order of tasks decided by random draw during the competitor briefing

Deductions for lane deviations

Opening separation penalties

2Way Acrobatic Wingsuiting:

Tie break round Compusory/Free determination by draw

20% penalty if judges can't determine the start of working time

Speed Skydiving:

Technical Scoring Director role defined

Equipment inspections

SMD placement

Changing rigs during competition

SMD's recording exit altitude
